

Water monitoring bores

DRILLING of seven water monitoring bores will begin on Monday, March 9, 2009. The water monitoring bores are being established following consultation with the Bulga Community Consultative Committee (BCCC).

To reduce the time period of drilling, we will use two drill rigs. We anticipate the drilling will be completed in two weeks.

The water bores will be established in three locations, known as BM01, BM02 and BM03. At BM01 there will be three water monitoring bores drilled, and two monitoring bores each at BM02 and BM03. The bores will be drilled to varying depths and will be approximately 5 metres apart. Please refer to the map overleaf to view the locations of the water monitoring bores.

The drill rigs are approximately 12 metres and 6 metres in height and are used for the relatively shallow drilling of standard domestic water bores.

There will be approximately six people on site operating the rigs and two representatives from Parsons Brinkerhoff will monitor the process. Sydney Gas staff members will visit the site regularly and continue to liaise with the property owner at all stages of the process.

Before the drill rigs arrive we will mow and whipper snipper sections of the site where the drill rigs will be operating and for general maintenance of the property.

Hours of drilling will be:

Monday – Friday, 7am until 6pm

We have chosen not to drill on weekends
